Planet Aid is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit that pioneered textile reuse in 1997 to protect the environment and raise funds for locally led community development. We partner with U.S. communities, businesses and nonprofits to reduce textile waste in landfills and fundraise. Donated clothes and shoes help fuel a second hand, circular economy that provides livelihoods and clothes for millions of people. Proceeds from used clothes donations are used to fund locally led community development programs that promote education, health and wellness, and environmental and agricultural sustainability in the U.S., Latin America, Africa and Asia.

Textile reuse also reduces demand for new clothes which uses precious, limited resources like water and contributes to CO₂ and pesticide pollution.

Fashion Facts

- 92 million tons of clothes end up in landfills annually
- The average U.S. consumer throws away ~82 lbs. of clothes annually
- The fashion industry is responsible for 20% of global waste water
- Fast fashion accounts for 10% of global carbon emissions
- Nearly 10% of microplastics that ends up in oceans is from textiles
